NEW RIDE FOR 2009!

A choice of 100 mile or 50 mile routes starting and finishing on the seafront near Brighton.

From the start on the seafront at Hove the ride heads east through Brighton and along the South Coast to Newhaven where the two routes split. The 50 mile route then follows the river Ouse, climbing gently over the Downs past Glyndebourne's famous opera house before turning west to Hurstpierpoint and skirting the 'Devil's Dyke' on its return to the finish at Hove.

Start Times **100-mile ride:** 7.00am – 8.00am. Individual times printed on Entry Pack envelope and Time Card.

50-mile ride: 8.00am – 9.00am at a time to suit you.

Pre-registered riders don't need to come and sign up. Just go to the Start and get cycling.

Refreshments Refill water bottles and buy food and drink at refreshment stops along the routes.
